**General Labourers**, for the following Departments:

- Other duties as required;
- Some weekend or evening shifts may be required.

### **Weed Inspector Responsibilities:**

- Conduct weed inspections and pest inspections as directed.
- Develop producer's awareness on various weed control practices as outlined in publications.
- Perform duties as required by the Weed Control Act, Agricultural Pests Act, and local Agricultural Service Board policy.
- Some overtime or shift work may be required.

**Environmental Technician Responsibilities:**

- Assist with the planning and implementation of the Environmental/Watershed programs throughout the County, both seasonal and strategic.
- Assist in the planning, promotion and implementation of environmental educational programs, such as the “Mad About Science Program” and the “Lac La Biche County Land Stewardship Program”.

- Minimum of Post Secondary Diploma in environmental, conservation or biological sciences, or comparable education and/or experience in the environmental field;
