Draft Land Use Bylaw Review

Council met to discuss the progress of the County's new draft Land Use Bylaw (LUB) revisions. Otherwise known as a "zoning bylaw" the LUB will regulate how and where land in the County can be developed—what types of buildings are allowed on certain properties, and where they can be placed, as well as requirements for construction and development. The LUB will include regulations and guidelines for houses, secondary suites, decks and sheds, renovations, new landscaping, parking, signage, and work camps. Stakeholder sessions were held over the winter to obtain feedback from residents, business owners and local developers and work has been ongoing with Council and the County's LUB consultants to refine the final draft.

Council met again with consultants to further discuss best practices for parking stall requirements, work camps, RV storage and signage regulations. Consultants will return with more updates and revisions for Council's review, and Council hopes to give first reading to the new LUB in the fall. Once first reading has been given, residents will have another chance to provide feedback at a public hearing.
