

Lac La Biche Rotary Club: Adult Exercise Park

- In 2014, Council met with representatives from the Lac La Biche Rotary Club to discuss a possible partnership with the County to develop a fitness park in the hamlet of Lac La Biche.
- At that time, the club presented their idea for the park, which would include a number of stations that could be incorporated into a fitness routine, i.e. pull up bars, squat station, warm-up station, etc. The placement of these fitness stations along a walking trail in the hamlet was also discussed.
- The Rotary Club indicated that they would be willing to pay for the equipment and its installation, asking that the County provide land for the park, as well as site preparation and equipment maintenance once installed.
- At this week's meeting, Council discussed the project again. Council directed Administration to forward a letter to the club expressing the County's intent to find a location for the adult exercise park and authorizing Administration to negotiate and enter into an agreement allocating lands for the park.

Lac La Biche County Sand and Salt Storage Building

- Council approved additional funds in the amount of \$150,000 to complete the construction of the County's new sand and salt storage building.
- The original budget for the building was \$621, 400, however, after construction began, it became clear it would be necessary to engineer and enhance electrical and exhaust systems in the building. Staff also requested additional funding to install an inner concrete wall that would protect the lower half of the building's wooden shell from equipment when sand and salt is being loaded and unloaded.
- The final budget for the building is \$771, 404.

Churchill Drive Paving

- Council discussed options and cost implications for the Churchill Drive paving project, from the cost of overlay paving to the milling of the entire roadway.
- Council approved the use of existing 2015 capital budget funds to cover the cost of milling, resurfacing, as well as curb, gutter and sidewalk replacement for the paving project slated for Churchill Drive, from 101B Avenue to 100 Street.
