



Toilet Rebate Program

April 2010

Lac La Biche County is introducing a new incentive program to help county residents reduce water consumption. Effective January 1, 2010 county residents are eligible for a rebate of up to \$100 when they replace an old toilet with an eligible low-flush toilet or dual flush toilet.

Old toilets can waste a large amount of water. If your toilet was manufactured before the early 1990's, they likely use more than 20 litres per flush - more if they leak. On a one person basis, that can add up to a bathtub worth of clean water per day per, and over a year, require more than 35,000 litres of water to dispose of 650 litres of body waste.

Water is one of our most precious resources and we need to do everything we can to conserve its use. Old wasteful toilets should be replaced with newer more efficient models that will not only save in water usage, but also save on your water bill and reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

Product

Low Flush Toilet: \$75 rebate

Dual-Flush Toilet: \$100 rebate

Toilets must be on the ecoENERGY approved list of toilets. This list is available on the following website: <http://www.veritec.ca/mid.php?code=33&top=6&option=7&img=5>. Once the Veritec website window opens, please click the word "Download" to view the list.

Eligibility Requirements

- The new toilet must be purchased on or after January 1, 2010.
- The new toilet must replace an existing toilet.
- The new toilet must be on the ecoENERGY approved list of toilets. The approved list consists of toilets that have been tested for water usage and flush performance.
- Rebate limit is **two** toilets per household. (*Previous information stated one toilet.*)
- Applications must be received by March 31, 2011.
- The replaced toilets should be removed from the home and disposed of properly. Old toilets can be brought to any of the seven landfill sites in the county for proper disposal (see county website for locations and hours of operation).

Application Requirements

In order to submit an application form, you will need the following items:

- Completed application form.
- Purchase receipt indicating the payment method (in full) along with the manufacturer and model of the toilet purchased and the date purchased.

Application process

- All applications will be submitted to **Climate Change Central** for review, approval and rebate payment distribution.
- Applications should be mailed or faxed to Climate Control Central.
- All questions and concerns towards the eligibility or application process can be directed to Climate Control Central.
- Do NOT send application forms to Lac La Biche County.
- Rebates will be issued by Climate Control Central, while quantities last.
