POLICY STATEMENT:

Alberta's Animal Health Act authorizes municipalities to implement the Animal Health Regulations in response to animal diseases affecting animal health, public health, and food safety. In partnership with the Provincial Chief Veterinary Officer, Lac La Biche County, through the Agricultural Service Board, shall assist Provincial and Federal authorities in the event of a disease outbreak; with the Agricultural Fieldman as the designated officer to administer the Animal Health Act.

PRINCIPLES:

In the event of an outbreak of a reportable animal disease, County employees will assist in disseminating
all relevant information to residents, livestock owners and agricultural producers in the municipality
utilizing all applicable methods of communication available. Additional departments, resources, and
plans (such as the County's Emergency Livestock Management Plan) may be consulted and utilized as
required.
