## **PROCEDURE:**

- 1. Community groups and non-profit organizations may request a letter from Lac La Biche County Council offering the County's endorsement for that group to receive grants or funding. These requests often have tight timelines, and require a quick response.
- 2. The Communications department will prepare letters of support for the Mayor's signature without a Council resolution, so long as the letters do not make any financial or service-related commitments that require a Council resolution.
- 3. The Communications department may choose to use the Mayor's electronic signature with the Mayor's consent.
- 4. Council will be sent letters via email before they are mailed, and will have 24 hours to review them.
- 5. Lac La Biche County Council will continue to be copied on all letters of support, and will be kept informed of Council correspondence.
