

**BYLAW 26-004
OF
LAC LA BICHE COUNTY**

A BYLAW OF LAC LA BICHE COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO REVISE BYLAW 21-012, AS AMENDED BY BYLAW 22-005, BEING A ROAD CLOSURE BYLAW.

WHEREAS Council has adopted Bylaw 21-012 for the purpose of closing to public travel and disposing of portions of a public roadway;

AND WHEREAS the legal description cited in Bylaw 21-012 requires revision to enable the road closure to be registered with the Alberta Land Titles Office;

AND WHEREAS section 63 of the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M-26, R.S.A. 2000, as amended (“the Act”) authorizes the passing of a bylaw that makes bylaw changes, without materially affecting the bylaw in principle or substance, to bring out more clearly what is considered to be the meaning of a bylaw;

AND WHEREAS section 63 of the Act requires the Chief Administrative Officer to certify in writing that the proposed revisions were prepared in accordance with section 63 prior to first reading;

AND WHEREAS section 65 of the Act provides that a bylaw made in accordance with section 63, and the resulting revised bylaw, are deemed to have been made in accordance with all other requirements of the Act, respecting the passing and approval of those bylaws, including any requirements for advertising and public hearings;

NOW THEREFORE under the authority and subject to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act*, and by virtue of all other powers enabling it, the Council of Lac La Biche County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

Revisions to Bylaw 21-012

- 1 Bylaw 21-012 is revised by this bylaw.
- 2 Bylaw 22-005 is repealed by this bylaw.
- 3 The title of Bylaw 21-012 is deleted and replaced with:

REVISED BYLAW 21-012, A BYLAW OF LAC LA BICHE COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND DISPOSING OF PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC ROADWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M-26, R.S.A. 2000, AS AMENDED.

- 4 The legal description in Bylaw 21-012 is revised by deleting section 1 in its entirety and replacing it with:

All those portions of road forming part of Subdivision Plan 092 3981 and Plan 212 1335, containing, in total, 0.303 hectares (0.75 acres), more or less, shown as Areas 'A', 'B', 'C' and 'D' on Plan 262 _____, excepting thereout all mines and minerals, are hereby closed.

5 Bylaw 21-012 is revised by deleting Schedule "A" in its entirety.

Effective Date

6 This bylaw shall come into effect upon passing of the third reading.
