Shallow Water Attendants **Casual Positions**

The purpose of this position is to monitor shallow water pools (less than 1.2 meters deep), communicate and educate the public about safe and appropriate use of the facility, and response to minor emergencies under the guidance of Certified National Lifeguards. The Shallow Water Attendant will assist with other Portage Pool duties, as required.

Responsible for:

- Monitors activities of the swimming pool and surrounding areas;
- Understands and applies facility and emergency policies and procedures;
- Enforces pool rules and Alberta Health Regulations with patrons using the pool;
- Assists with administering first aid treatment and emergency response procedures;
- Assists with the routine maintenance and daily cleanliness of the facility;
- Assists with public education, outreach strategies, and promotion of aquatic programs and services as required;

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 14 years of age;
- Must hold a current Lifesaving Society Bronze Cross award
- Standard First Aid & CPR-C would be an asset
- Some experience in aquatics is preferred (swim club, athlete, participant)
- Ability to spend significant amounts of time standing and/or in the water
- Demonstrated ability to work well in a team environment
- Must submit a Driver's Abstract, Criminal Record Check, Child Welfare Check and Medical Assessment that meets the satisfaction of the County.
