

BYLAW 20-025

A BYLAW OF LAC LA BICHE COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND BYLAW 20-023, BEING THE FIRE BYLAW OF LAC LA BICHE COUNTY.

WHEREAS Council adopted Lac La Biche County Bylaw 20-023 to be used as the Lac La Biche County Fire Bylaw; and

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to amend Bylaw 20-023, pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE under the authority and subject to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act*, and by virtue of all other powers enabling it, the Council of Lac La Biche County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

Fire Bylaw Amendments

1 Bylaw 20-023, being the Fire Bylaw is amended as follows:

(a) Section 9(2)(c) is amended by striking out “minimum” and substituting “maximum”, and will now read:

has walls which are a maximum of 0.60 metres in height measured from the floor of the Fire Pit to the top of the wall of the Fire Pit excluding any chimney.

(b) Schedule ‘A’ LLBCFR Fines and Penalties 9(2) is amended by deleting the repeated words “not meeting”, and will now read:

Unapproved Fire Pit not meeting one or more requirements

Severability

2 Each provision of this Bylaw is independent of all other provisions. If any such provision is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all other provisions of this Bylaw will remain valid and enforceable.

Effective Date

3 This bylaw shall come into effect upon passing of the third reading.
