The Board meets as required and is seeking up to four (4) Members at Large for a term of three (3) years. Please note that the *Municipal Government Act* requires Members to successfully complete a training program (training programs can range either a full day or up to three half days) in accordance with the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board Regulation, and the term date will coincide with the successful completion of the SDAB certification training.
